Maths

We will continue to count in multiples of twos, fives and also tens. We begin to look at numbers to 50 and begin to understand the order backwards and forwards. We will also be introducing length and height and looking at different ways to measure mass and capacity.

Science

We will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

We will continue to notice changes in the outside environment linked to the spring season.

RE

We will learn that we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus at Easter, that he rose from the dead and appeared to his disciples. We will hear the story of Jesus and Thomas and know that Jesus returned to heaven.

PE

We will continue developing ball skills and focussing on sending and receiving. We will be developing how to roll or throw a ball at a target.
