

English

We will use books such as The Great Fire: A City in Flames to support our understanding of our history topic. We will use a range of non-fiction books to explore the four countries of the UK and the book Brick to enhance our learning in art.

Maths

We will be learning the language of position, direction and movement. We will explore efficient methods for problem solving. We will begin to learn to tell the time to five minutes and measure mass, temperature and capacity.

Science

We will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

RE

In the final term we will revise what happened after the Resurrection. We will learn that the Apostles received the Holy Spirit and reflect on how it helped them. We will know how Jesus helped Peter and John.

PE

In team games, we will be working on our striking and fielding skills, building up to a game of rounders. We will prepare for Sports Day with a range of athletic activities.

Art & Design/ Design & Technology

In art, we will use sculpture to explore architects and buildings.
We will make a mechanical stage set to include a moving fire with one moving piece.

History/ Geography

We will be learning about the significance of the Great Fire of London. This will include how the fire started, the impact of the fire and the life of Samuel Pepys. We will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.

Computing

In our first unit we will create pictures using 2paint a picture, including saving, editing and retrieving files. After half term, we will be learning how to use presentation software.

Music

We will create descriptive class compositions using voices and instruments. We will sing and play a variety of pitch shapes and use simple notation. We will learn a Tanzanian game song and listen to an orchestral piece.
