

### **English**

Our class reader will be chosen by the children  
In reading lessons, we will learn read *I was there... Boudica's Army* which is set in Roman Britain. We will write a narrative poem based on this. We will also write recounts based on Pompeii.

### **Maths**

We will continue working with decimals and will solve problems involving time and money.  
In statistics, we will be introduced to line graphs. We will further our knowledge of properties of 2D shapes and begin to use coordinates in the first quadrant.

### **Science**

We will learn about the human digestive system and different types of teeth. We will construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

### **RE**

We will learn that the Church began at Pentecost and consider the challenges of being an apostle. We will learn about the seasons in the Church's year as well as deepening our understanding of Mary.

### **History/ Geography**

We will learn about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. Through studying a region in Italy, we will identify human and physical characteristics. We will also learn about volcanoes and earthquakes.
