

### **English**

Our class reader will be the classic *Wind in the Willows* and we will write a persuasive speech based on events within the story. In reading lessons, we will be reading the *Wind in the Willows* and then follow this with a series of theme weeks.

### **Maths**

We will learn to add and subtract decimal numbers and to use a protractor to measure angles. We will reflect and translate shapes in the first quadrant. We will convert between different units of measurement and be introduced to volume.

### **Science**

We will describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals and describe the changes as humans develop to old age .

### **RE**

We will consider what the Resurrection means for us and how we can be present with Jesus. We will learn some Jewish and Muslim beliefs and practices we share and some of the differences, and consider their importance.

### **History/ Geography**

We will undertake a local history study. We will use fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods focusing on rivers and human geography.
