

English

We will learn about the Galapagos through our class reader Darwin's Dragons. We will learn to write a police report based on the text, 'The Giant's Necklace', and a discussion text to debate eco-tourism on the Galapagos.

Maths

We will learn about angles in triangles, quadrilaterals and regular polygons. We will interpret and construct pie charts and name parts of a circle. We will apply our knowledge in many areas of maths to problem solving and investigations.

Science

We will describe how living things are classified into broad groups and give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics. We will learn about fossils, variation and adaptation and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

RE

We will learn about the Ascension and Pentecost as well as deepening our understanding of Peter and Paul. Through learning about some Sacraments, we will know how some people responded to God's call.

Year 6 Summer Term Galapagos

History/ Geography

We will explore the life of Charles Darwin. We will use maps to plot his journey around the world, concentrating on the Galapagos environmental regions, and key physical and human characteristics.

Art & Design/ Design & Technology
